Responsibilities of the CSR Committee

The responsibilities of the CSR Committee include:

- Monitoring and ensuring fair implementation & reporting of the CSR activities
- Selecting any external partners engaged to support the CSR process in Thoughtworks
- Setting expectations around their involvement and ensuring they are delivered to them

Funding and monitoring process

This year Thoughtworks continued partnering with an external organization to manage the CSR process and portfolio including review of existing CSR partners, scouting for new projects to align with the CSR policy, performing an evaluation and due-diligence of the CSR partners to refine the project proposals and plans, define goals, metrics, conduct impact assessments, streamline reporting and submit quarterly reports to the CSR Committee.
